Snow Day Packet Directions:

Wildcat Day - 4

Your child must complete one activity from each section (reading and math). Color the box for the activity chosen. All work is due the day following the snow day.

Reading	Math
Write each color word: red, blue, green, yellow, orange, pink, purple, gray, tan, black, brown, white. Then look through a magazine and find pictures that are that color. Cut the pictures out and glue next to the color word it matches.	Count backwards from 10 while doing jumping jacks. Then try to count backwards from 20 and then from 30.
Read a story. Draw the characters and setting of the story.	Toss a ball back and forth with a partner and count to 100.
Toss a ball back and forth with a partner and practice rhyming words. (e.g. one person says a word "cat" and tosses the ball. The person who catches the ball needs to say a word that rhymes with "cat". Change the rhyming word after a few tosses.).	Rainbow write your numbers to 100 or as far as you can go.
Look in a magazine or newspaper for simple CVC type pictures (e.g. cat, dog, cup, rug, etc.). Glue them on a piece of paper and write the beginning, middle and ending sound of the word.	Look in a magazine or newspaper and find numbers 1-10. Cut them out and glue them in order.
